Trip to Cameroon



In December, Anna and I were able to return to Cameroon, where we met in high school and God fused our hearts with a vision for missions. We went to her village of Lassin to **celebrate the translation of the Nooni New Testament** with the Noni people.

If I could summarize our trip to Cameroon it would be this; I saw the impact of one person's obedience to God. A childhood friend led Anna's dad to the Lord in college. She had no idea that years down the road, a New Testament in an unwritten language would result.

30,000 people speak Nooni. Years ago, **one person was not ashamed of the gospel and now 30,000 people have the Word of God** in their mother tongue. The beautiful thing is, it doesn't stop there. The Nooni translation team is now moving on to 6 other languages that need the Word of God too. It doesn't take long to see the pyramid

effect of how the faithfulness and obedience of one person (and all those in between) has a great effect for the glory of God's kingdom.

This gave me an amazing sense of responsibility to be faithful no matter where I am to be bold and share the gospel with those around me. It is so easy to see the end goal and forget about the importance of the *process*. **I have an amazing opportunity to live each**
