Dear Friends and Family,

We are on the final stretch to serving overseas! There are just a few more key events that need to take place and a thousand little details. My last semester teaching at Moody Aviation starts next week and goes until the end of June. I have the fantastic privilege of teaching in the "Transitions" semester. It takes the newly rated pilots and moves them into high performance, complex and tailwheel airplanes. I will be teaching in an airplane similar to the one pictured above.

The second key event is Technical Orientation starting the beginning of September. This is where we move down to North Carolina to spend three months of focused technical equipping before boarding an airplane to Kenya. This second step is contingent on God providing our needs. The concept is similar to assuring there is enough fuel in the airplane before launching into the air.

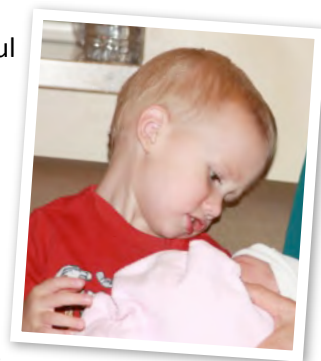
If you are not already, would you consider regularly praying for us? As God provides for your needs and leads you, would you consider joining the team that contributes to this ministry?
