Many of you have already heard our big news, but for those of you that haven't, here it is—**we are returning to mission aviation!**

Over the last several years, Angie and I have often had discussions about what it could look like to return to a role in mission aviation. The ministry of Righteous Rides meets a critical need and we have loved being a part of caring for the missionary families that use our vans. Our ten years serving as a pilot/mechanic family in Brazil with Wycliffe Bible Translators were also extremely fulfilling and valuable, and a desire to apply our training and experience in the mission aviation context has remained. We have considered different options at different times, but until recently the Lord has always made it clear that it wasn't time to make a change.

In October, we visited friends who serve at SMAT, "School of Missionary Aviation Technology," in Ionia, Michigan. SMAT provides students with training in aircraft maintenance and flight, with a focus on preparing them to serve the Lord in mission aviation. In December, I was offered a position to join the flight training team, giving initial flight instruction and mentoring students as they prepare to serve in aviation overseas. After much prayer and counsel and conversations, we accepted!

We are so thankful for the opportunity to join the work taking place at SMAT. It is exciting to know that we can help mentor these students preparing to serve in mission aviation and join the SMAT team in its purpose: to make an impact for God's Kingdom through aviation.

to be a part of reaching the nations with the gospel of Jesus Christ.
