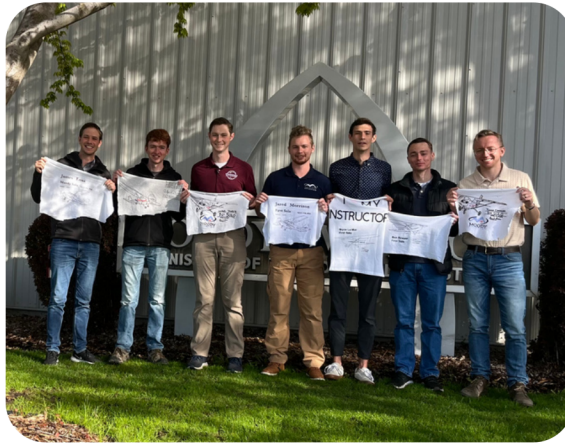

As a refresher, our commitment to Moody/Proclaim ends at the end of this June and we are in the process of transitioning to Africa Inland Mission (AIM). The end goal is that we will serve in Nairobi, Kenya as a missionary mechanic couple, where we will support church planting. With that transition comes many moving pieces that require major prayer:

- Our AIM application has been submitted and accepted for the next steps of the hiring process. Praise the Lord!
- The next step of the process is an interview with the AIM representatives **next week!** Pray that this interview goes well.
- Concluding a positive interview, we will attend the AIM Engage week in mid-July. This is essentially AIM's onboarding week for new missionaries. After this, we will be full-fledged AIM missionaries.
- We are planning on moving to Georgia to be closer to AIM HQ and Amber's family for the birth of our son.
- For the next 6-8 months after July, we will be doing various trainings with AIM and ministry support raising.
- Amber will be stepping out of aviation for a long season to focus on the incredible blessing of being a mom. This is a decision that we have considered, prayed about, and consulted many spiritual mentors over the past year.
