On November 5th I passed my checkride for my instructor instrument rating–essentially now allowing me to teach students to fly in the clouds. My first assignment

My first assignment with Proclaim is building a team of ministry partners! My position with them as a pilot/mechanic is a support-funded position. Biblical Support-Raising

Is it biblical to raise support? Is fundraising just begging for money? Didn't Paul work to support himself in ministry?

If you've ever asked these questions, you're not alone. One of the first things Proclaim has new members do is a training on support raising—both the practical steps and the biblical foundation behind it. Before the training, I hadn't realized just how much Scripture speaks to living and ministering on support!

God's provision for those in ministry is woven throughout the Bible. I can't cover it all here, but if you want to explore further, look at: God's provision for the Levites (Num. 18), Jesus' own support-based ministry (Luke 8:1–3), Paul's request for the Roman church's support (Rom. 15:24), Paul's teaching on a minister's right to material support (1 Cor. 9), his instruction on cheerful giving (2 Cor. 8–9), and John's description of financial supporters as fellow workers for the truth (3 John 8).

Philippians offers one of the clearest pictures of the relationship between supporters and those in ministry. From the start, Paul prays for his supporters and calls them partners in the gospel (1:5). In 4:10-20, he holds a delicate tension between genuine thankfulness for their care and yet being fully reliant on God as his ultimate provider. He recognizes the true nature of the Philippians' gifts as offerings to the Lord and remains content, confident that God will meet all his needs.

I hope to grow in that same confidence in God's provision, while seeking those God is prompting to be my partners in ministry, just as the Philippians were for Paul.
