Operations Update

We rejoice in many ways that God has provided for Moody Aviation (MA). What we thought would be a very challenging term for maintenance, God has provided the personnel and pace to accomplish inspections in good time with few, if any, interruptions in the flight schedule. As an organization, we are receiving increasingly strong support from Moody Bible Institute Chicago (MBI). Additionally, we are beginning to take advantage of MBI's decision to make MA an independent school within their internal structure. This means that we have the capacity to begin good, healthy operations based on our organization's specific needs. Funding will still largely come through Moody Chicago; however, there are now ventures that MA can pursue to build a long-standing organization in an advancing and increasingly more expensive world. Pray that God gives grace to sustain us and help us bring on the right professionals to make this a reality. Faith and I are very eager to be a part of this foundation-forming period so that aviation missions can be well supplied with faithful men and women ready for one of the highest and most challenging callings of reaching the world's most isolated with the gospel of peace.
