

Ministry Update

Sometimes we find ourselves in situations we never expected. In those moments, we can do one of two things: either become frustrated that our vision for *our* kingdom did not come to fruition, or rejoice that God is building *His* kingdom — even if that means gently tearing away our desires for this world.

Our winter trip to Switzerland came with some unexpected changes. MAF Switzerland, along with several other MAF entities, will cease to exist in June and be consolidated under MAF International. However, MAF International operates under a different philosophy. They do not consider themselves a missions organization in the traditional sense, but rather function as an NGO under a business model.

Because of this shift — and because they operate their own flight schools in the Netherlands and Australia — it no longer makes sense for them to continue employing us once MAF Switzerland transitions under the MAF International umbrella.

This came as a surprise and was difficult news to process. We were saddened by the shift in direction and the implications it held for us. MAF US, however, is large enough within the overall structure that it will remain autonomous and continue operating fully as a missions organization.

Now, essentially being fired by MAF come June left us somewhat stranded. However, the Lord has been preparing our hearts for about a year and has challenged us with the possibility of a delayed


