Biblical support.

I am deeply convinced that partnership in ministry is essential to God's design. Scripture shows this in both the Old and New Testaments. In the Old Testament, the Levites were set apart to serve the Lord and lead the community in worship, and God provided for them through the generosity of the other tribes (Deut. 18:1–8).

In the New Testament, the Apostle Paul describes ministry partnership as a shared participation in the work of the gospel—marked by interdependence, the joy of participating together in the advance of the gospel, and a posture of trust in God as our ultimate provider. This kind of partnership is not merely financial, but a meaningful spiritual and relational investment that brings joy and lasting fruit for all involved. (3 John 5–8; Phil. 4:10–20; 2 Cor. 9)
